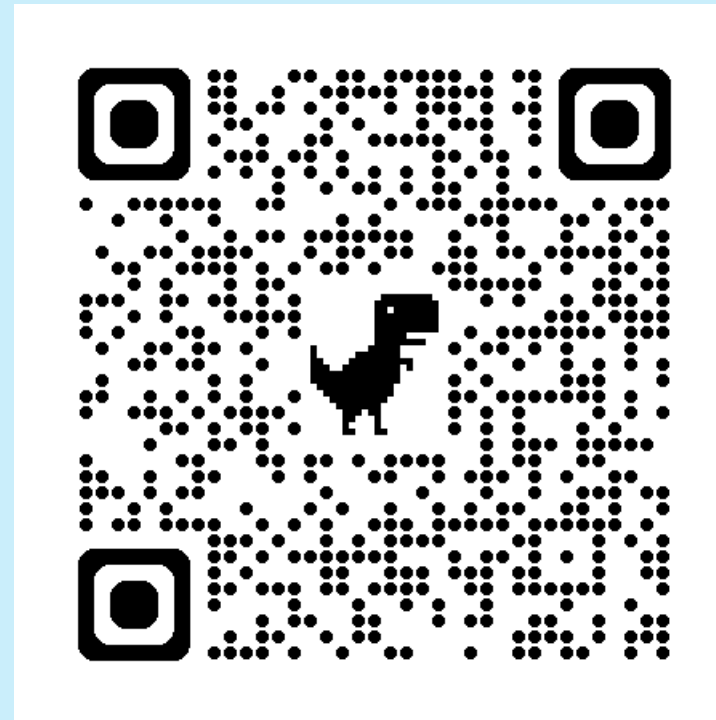

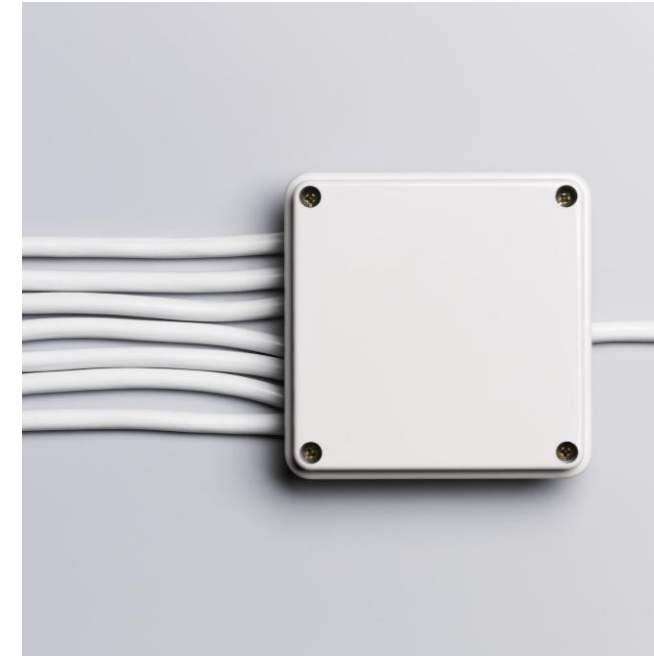

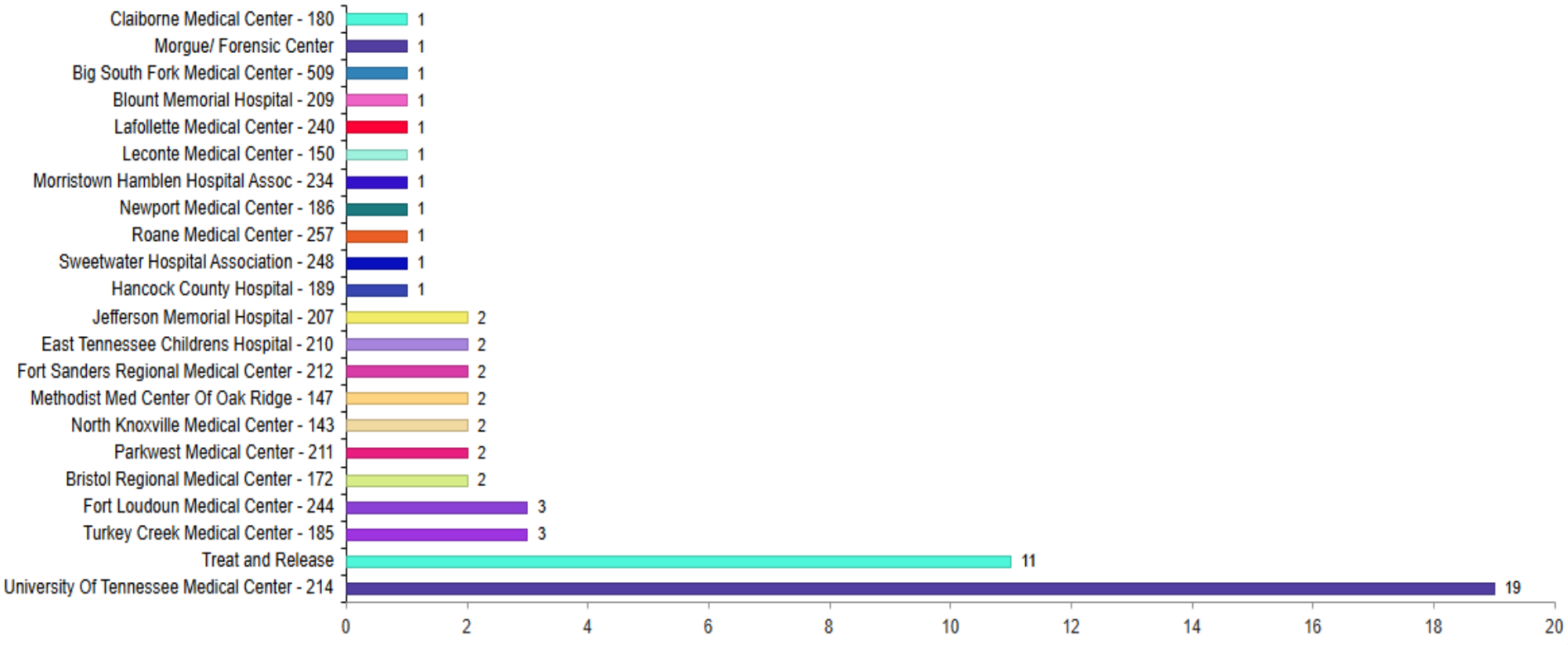

- Working on plan to have RMCC as gate keeper for Knox Co



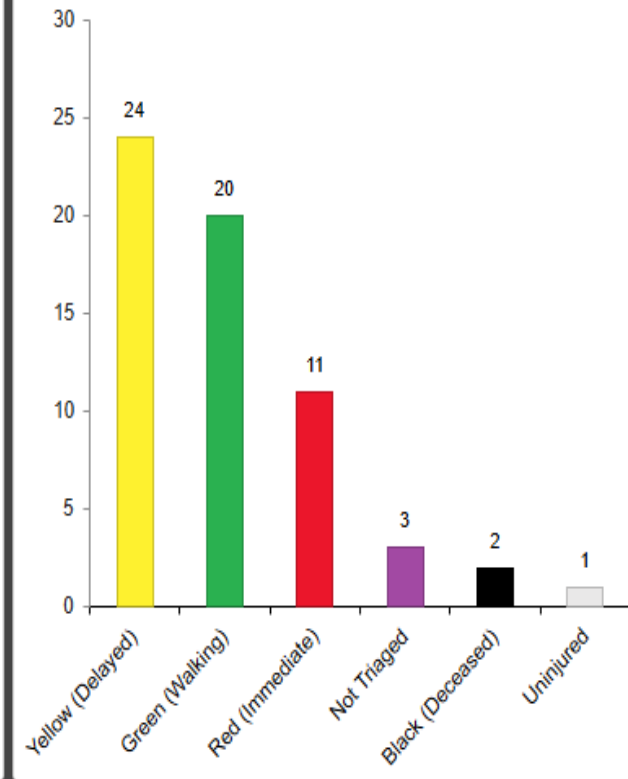

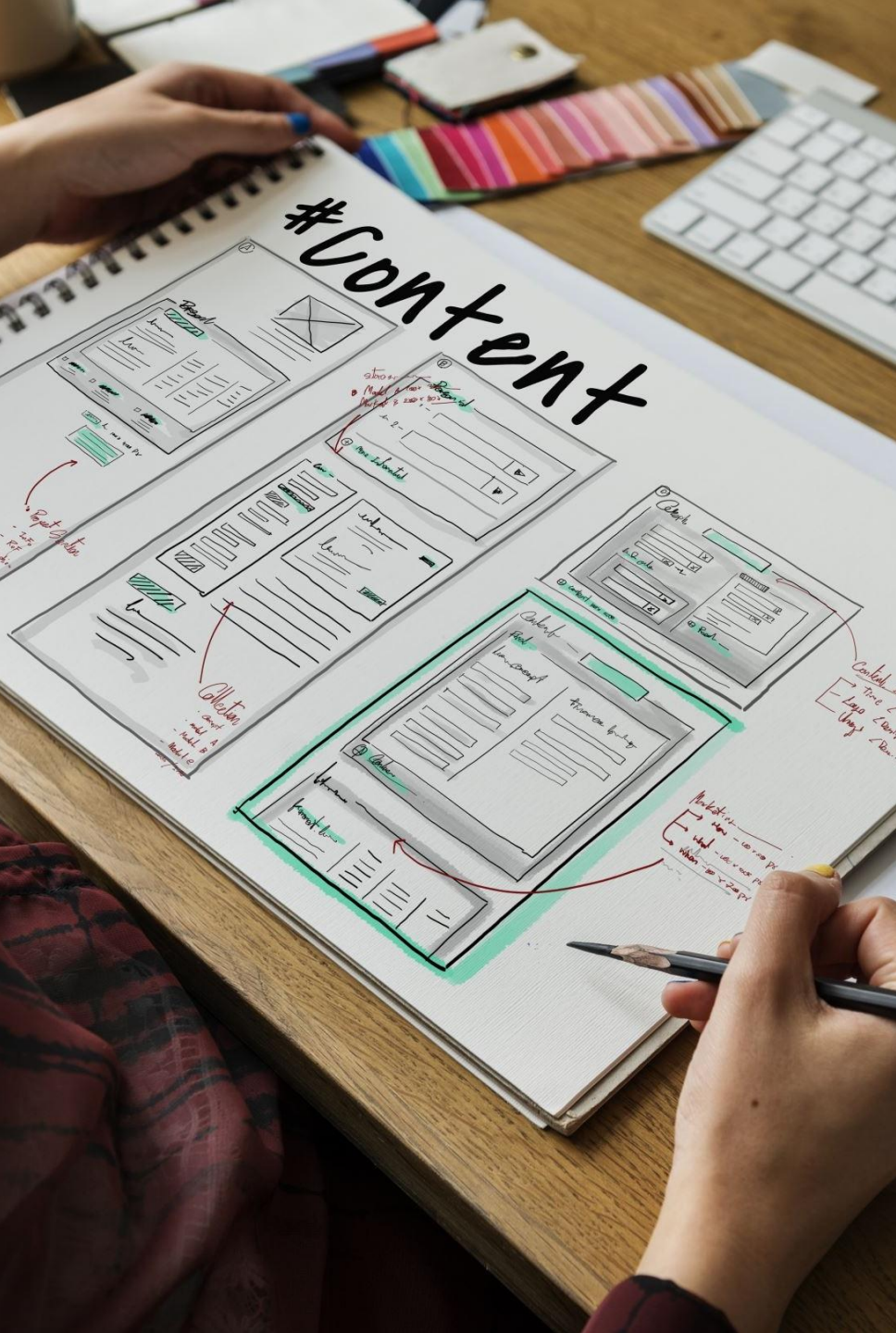

CHEMPACK Containers

- CHEMPACK containers are self-contained units placed in strategic locations to enable first responders to quickly administer life-saving antidotes and save lives.
- There are two types of containers:
 - **EMS containers**
 - Geared to first responders
 - 85% auto injectors
 - 454 casualty capacity
 - **Hospital Containers**
 - Geared to clinical care environment
 - 85% Multi-dose vials
 - 1,000 casualty capacity
